



Guidance Notes on the Application Process for the Brighton CAT Practitioner Training 2022

- **A full CV**
- **An account of some of your important life experiences and how they may have led you to seek training as a CAT Practitioner (word limit 600 words)**

The closing date for applications is 31st December 2021. Applicants will be short-listed and will be interviewed from January 2022 onwards. Applicants are urged to apply as soon as possible as places are limited and successful applicants will be offered places on a first come first served basis. Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their interviews once the interview process has been completed.

Successful applicants will be expected to set up their clinical placements before April 2022, so that they can commence those placements straight away at the beginning of the course.

The course fees are £3900 per year. A discretionary reduction in fees will be applied to those who apply for the bursary scheme. The amount applied will depend on the financial viability of the training and is unlikely to be more than 20% of the fees.
