Applicants are urged to apply as soon as possible as places are limited and successful applicants will be offered places on a first come first served basis. Applicants will be notified about the outcome of their interviews once the interview process has been completed.

Successful applicants will be expected to set up their clinical placements before September 2019, so that they can commence those placements straight away at the beginning of the course.
